**Safeguarding Policy**  
**Juniors Participating In Adult Hockey**

**10<sup>th</sup> October 2019**

Eastcote Hockey Club have safeguarding policies for Juniors under 18 in accordance with guidelines from England Hockey. Juniors are required to register each year and provide telephone numbers and any relevant medical information and authorise Eastcote HC to take any emergency action necessary in the event of a medical situation. This information is passed on to the relevant coaches for Junior Hockey activities.

Juniors aged 13 or over are permitted to participate in adult hockey if deemed to be capable by the coaches and if the parent or guardian is agreeable. To make certain that the adult captain / organiser has the necessary medical and contact information that is held by the Junior coaches, the Junior is required to provide a completed "Juniors Safeguarding Card Adult Hockey" to the adult team captain / organiser if they are taking part in adult hockey unless they are accompanied by a responsible person. This card should be readily accessible throughout the period that they are under the supervision of the captain / organiser.

It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian of the Junior to ensure that a duly completed card is carried by the Junior to all and every adult hockey session. If the card is not presented by the Junior, the captain / organiser will not be able to take any necessary action if an emergency arises.

A blank copy of the card is below. It is designed to be cut round the outside border and folded once to a credit card size for easy use.
